11	Students Should Be Aware of the Following Regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● #2 - Students not permitted to have more than two study halls, unless enrolled in an experiential learning program. ● #5 - A grade of F will be assigned to students who withdraw from a course after the 1st and 3rd quarter interim.
11	Weighted Courses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Addition of C-STAG courses - new requirement of ODEW. ● Remove language stating CCP courses are only weighted where a comparable subject is offered at Columbian.
17	Summer School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Addition of OST intervention opportunity for students. Districts are required to offer some form of OST intervention to students for retake purposes.
17	Art Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Addition of art course “tiers” to help students better understand the progression of skills required for courses as they advance through the levels of art classes ● Revision of Advanced Art course descriptions to emphasize the development of artistic skills needed to be successful in these courses
20	Business & Technology Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Change course title from “Entrepreneurship” to “Business Builders” ● Elimination of “You and the Law” from the course catalog due to low requests and amount of options in the department and only one teacher
22	English Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Change course title from “Public Speaking & Communication” to “Communications” ● Addition of new elective course “Journalism I: Foundations of Journalism” ● Addition of new elective course “AP Seminar”
27	Math Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Addition of math course “tiers” to help students better understand the progression of skills required for courses as they advance through the levels of math classes ● Elimination of Applied Geometry as a result of changes to the math course progression
31	Music Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Elimination of Music Theory I and II due to low enrollment numbers ● Addition of American Music History, Instrument Exploration & Performance, and Music Tech as new music electives in place of Music Theory I and II

32	Physical Education Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Addition of new elective course “Fit For Life” • Elimination of Health and Wellness CCP due to consistently low enrollment
34	Science Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elimination of Science Research Methods due to consistently low enrollment
36	Social Studies Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elimination of History of Global Conflict
39	Spanish Course Descriptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Change description from “World Languages” to “Spanish” due to no longer offering Chinese at Columbian. • Elimination of Chinese course descriptions • Elimination of AP Spanish Language and Culture • Addition of Conversational Spanish
