Before the meeting was called to order the council members walked through the 4 Base Camp rooms for Camp Invention.

Results from the groups:
 - a. Reinstate the Career Panels in the High School
 - b. Keep the Job/Career Fair
 - c. Look at doing something in the Middle School
 - Business Showcase before or after their Sentinel Tour
 - Business Showcase 4th quarter after the students have completed their Career Course.
 - Sponsor a large event for them to see careers and businesses in the area.
 - Work with the STEM teacher, Career teacher, and Curriculum Coordinator for ideas that fit their classes.
 - d. Possibly get parents to talk about their job in the elementary schools.
 - e. Look at robotics to get the students to work together, communicate with each other, and build some mechanical skills.

3. A very brief discussion was held about getting more business people on the Board. We have several going off and some that do not attend. To keep the council involved and strong, membership is extremely important.

4. The next meeting will be on Sept. 17. It was decided to skip July and August.

Dr. Beres adjourned the meeting, and the members toured the Camp Invention classroom.
